| Spring Topic Area | Skills coverage |
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| <p><i>Going down under</i></p> <p>FOCUS: Geography – comparing similarities and differences between the UK and Australia</p> <p>DRIVER Charity – creating a pop up art gallery to raise money for an animal charity.</p> | <p>English: Narrative + non-fiction. The children will be writing information texts about Australian animals. In addition they will be writing traditional tales based on Aboriginal dreamtime stories.</p> <p>Maths: Subtraction, multiplication and division, measurement and fractions.</p> <p>Art: As artists we will be exploring Aboriginal art. We will be creating our own designs and using them to make aboriginal patterns. We will also explore print making.</p> <p>Computing: The children will be using search engines to research Australian animals for an information booklet. They will learn how to copy, paste, save, retrieve and print using Power Point.</p> <p>P.E.: Children will be able to develop the fundamental skills of over arm throwing, running and striking the ball.</p> <p>Gym - developing skills in balancing, travelling, rolling and jumping. Creating own sequences and with partners.</p> <p>R.E.: Continuing the study of Muslims and how they live. Why does Easter matter to Christians?</p> <p>Science: We will be exploring habitats and food chains, describing what animals need to survive.</p> <p>Music: The children will explore Australian and British National Anthems, Aboriginal music and traditional Australian songs.
