In *Maths*, children will be developing skills in multiplication, weight and data handling.

In *English*, children will be writing a narrative piece linked to The Iron Man by Ted Hughes.

How you can help at home:

Spellings and multiplication tables practice are the most important skills you could develop at home. We also suggest reading for 10 minutes a right, where possible, as this is shown to have the greatest impact on a child's development.

As *Scientists*, the children will have opportunity to study and observe rocks and fossils learning how they are formed. They will also look at aspects of light.
