



In **Maths**, children will build on their knowledge and understanding of decimals, time, money, , statistics, measurement and geometry.

In **English**, children will further develop their skills in story writing linked to Alice, poetry , biography writing and non-chronological reports, through both their English and Topic lessons.

### How you can help at home:

Practise weekly spellings and multiplication tables.

# ALICE'S ADVENTURES IN WONDERLAND

As **Scientists**, children will learn to compare and group materials and explain the main stages of the water cycle.

In **Art**, children will explore the effect of adding things to paint such as glue and sawdust. They will also learn how to select materials for collage to contrast in texture and colour.

In **PSHCE**, children will be exploring keep safe inside and out . They will also be understanding the physical differences between males and females.

In **Computing**, children will be learning to combine a variety of software on a range of digital devices to present information effectively. We will also begin to understand the opportunities that computer networks offer for collaboration.

In **Geography**, children will be learning about aspects of physical geography including rivers. They will understand how people can improve the environment specifically river pollution.

In **RE**, children will explore how religious believers (Christians and Hindus) express meaning through festivals

In **PE**, children will be continuing developing their skills within athletics .  
**During indoor PE, the children will be learning a dance linked to our topic.**

In **DT**, children will be developing their cooking skills and techniques through making savoury and sweet dishes .

In **Music**, children will play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts using their voices and musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression.
