


# Year 2 Curriculum Overview

## Summer 2019

### Art - Drawing and painting

As artists we will be observing plants and creating line drawings using pencils and pens. We will also look at the work of botanical artists, creating paintings and prints.

### Physical Education

Dance: we will be developing a group dance incorporating the skills of stillness, travelling, gesture and formation.  
Athletics: to develop athletic skills such as running fast, changing direction and jumping for distance.

### Computing

We will be learning to program using LightBot software.

### Science

As scientists we will be looking at seeds and plants and the conditions needed to grow. We will be labelling different parts of a plant as well as discussing different uses for plants. We will be growing our own plants.

### English

We will be looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction texts including books on plants and growing. We will be developing our skills and knowledge of sentence structure, grammar and comprehension. We will be reading a range of poetry and will be writing our own version of *The Giant Jam Sandwich* by John Vernon Lord.

### Maths

We will be revising written methods for addition and subtraction. Learning about time, weight, capacity and developing our maths skills through problem solving.

### PSHE /Value

Our values this term are Responsibility and Honesty. We will reflect on the responsible use of medicines.

### Geography

We will be developing our mapping skills, looking at birds-eye view and using keys to show locations and land use. Our work will be linked to our English work- making maps linked to our story writing as well as mapping real places.

### Music-

We will be exploring instruments and symbols to make our own score. We will be learning to play the recorder.

### RE -

What is the good news Jesus brings?  
We will be listening to and reflecting on stories from the Bible recognising a link with the concept of 'Gospel' or good news. We will be learning how Christians believe Jesus' teachings make people think hard about how to live their lives.

### Design and Technology

We will be tasting and researching the making of jam and bread, ready to make our own jam sandwich.  
We will explore winding mechanisms, creating a 3D structure that re-creates a scene from *The Giant Jam Sandwich*.
